



INFORMATION for GOLF SOCIETY ORGANISERS

BOOKING YOUR SOCIETY DAY, COSTS AND PAYMENT

Details of the Golf packages and extras available, costs and menu options are shown on the 'Society Booking Form' which is enclosed.

To confirm your booking you must return the 'Society Booking Form', a deposit of £10 per head and a signed copy of the 'Agreement to Booking Conditions' within 21 days.

PAYMENT

Society accounts are required to be settled on the day and invoices are available from the bar following your game of golf. Payments may be made in cash, by a Single Company or Personal cheque, or by Credit/Debit card.

Any Muswell Hill Golf Club 'Playing' member in your Society will only be charged for meals.

CONDITIONS OF PLAY

Handicaps All players must have a Club or Society handicap.

Tee Reservations & Tee Times

The 1st tee is reserved for Societies. The 10th tee is a starting point for Club members and there is a system of alternate teeing off with those who have just played the 9th. We recommend:

- 8-10 minutes between tee times (3or 4 balls)
- 4.15 hours per round
- 5 hours between am and pm tee times (1 hour for lunch -eat as your come in).
- 5 hours between the last pm tee time and dinner being served (all eat together)

Society organisers are asked to ensure that their players are aware of their starting times, and the normal courtesies when on the course.

Trolleys Societies are subject to any restriction on the use of trolleys which may be in force. Please check the day before if the weather is unseasonal. Only wide wheeled trolleys are permitted.

ON YOUR GOLF DAY

Course Marshals. The Club operates a system of course marshals. The duty marshal should be your first point of contact on arrival. He will direct your players to the locker room, issue scorecards, nearest the pin and longest drive markers. and organise your teeing off.

Vehicle and Other Security - Your players should be meticulous in locking their vehicles and ensuring that tempting items are not readily visible in the car. Valuable items should not be left in the locker room. We cannot accept responsibility for items lost or stolen at Muswell Hill Golf Club.

Use of Club Facilities. All Club facilities are available to your group.

Professional's Shop (Tel: 020 8888 8046). Full pro-shop facilities are provided at Muswell Hill under the stewardship of David Wilton. As well as trolleys, buggies are available; however, it is recommended that buggies are pre-booked by phone beforehand.

Society Flags Society flags may be flown by arrangement.

Presentations A presentation table and microphone is available.

Nearest the Pin Nearest the Pin and Longest Drive markers are available.

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Agreement to Booking Conditions

- 1. I enclose a deposit of £10 per person in respect of the numbers booked. I acknowledge that if the numbers actually playing is less than the booked number the deposit in respect of the absence players is non-refundable.
- 2. I understand that the minimum number of participants to be charged is twelve with less than this number being charged as 12.
- 3. I understand that the deposit will not be refunded if cancellation is notified less than 21 days before the date of visit.
- 4. I agree to confirm the final numbers for catering 48 hours prior to the visit and understand that this will be the minimum charged for.
- 5. I agree to advise my Society members of the dress rules and general rules, tee times, and general conditions of play.

DRESS AND OTHER RULES (Please pass a copy to all members of your Society)

- ❖ As most member clubs, Muswell Hill pursues a policy of smart, casual attire, and members, guests and other visitors are required to dress accordingly. The Official Starter/Course Ranger, the Manager, the Steward, the Professional and his staff, any member of the Club's staff and all members of the Club have the authority to ask any person they believe to be improperly or unsuitably dressed to leave the Clubhouse or the Golf Course until such time as their attire conforms.

GENERAL GUIDELINES

- ❖ The following are unacceptable:
- ❖ jeans or denim clothing of any colour, type or brand
- ❖ shell suits and tracksuits
- ❖ combat trousers
- ❖ leggings
- ❖ rugby or football shirts
- ❖ untailed shorts
- ❖ clothing which bears oversized manufacturers' or sponsors' logos
- ❖ all sports shoes and trainers other than purpose-made golf shoes
- ❖ golf headgear in the club house, includes hats, caps and visors, except these may be worn in the entrance halls and locker rooms
- ❖ golf shoes in the club house, except that these may be worn in the spike bar, entrance halls and locker rooms
- ❖ the changing of clothing in the car park or any area external to the changing rooms
- ❖ clothing that is dirty, stained or soiled from play must not be worn in the lounge and dining areas
- ❖ trousers tucked into socks unless under waterproofs

SPECIFIC GUIDELINES

- ❖ MEN
- ❖ shirts must have collars (turtle / roll-necked shirts are acceptable), sleeves and be tucked in
- ❖ trousers must be full-length to the ankle
- ❖ shorts must be tailored and long
- ❖ shorts can only be worn with short, predominantly white sports socks or knee-length socks of any colour
- ❖ T-shirts cannot be worn
- ❖ Socks must be worn at all times
- ❖ LADIES
- ❖ low-cut and vest-style tops are not acceptable
- ❖ shorts should be tailored and long

On the Course, Please:

- ❖ Carry a pitch mark reparer and repair ALL pitch marks.
- ❖ Rake bunkers to the centre, and the leave rakes in the bunkers.
- ❖ Replace divots on fairways, and fill divots on tees from the divot boxes provided.
